Fill the circle corresponding to the answer you believe is correct with a **pencil**. If you no longer believe your answer is correct, erase your answer with a rubber and provide your new answer by filling the respective circle.

If you believe "A" is the correct answer, you mark "A":











If you change your mind and believe "B" is the correct answer, you erase your previous marking of answer "A" using your rubber. After you have erased your previous answer you fill the circle corresponding to what you now believe is correct, here "B":











• Do not make arrows or crosses or any other type of markings but erase your answer if you want to change it! If you provide more than one answer or if you provide ambiguous answers you will receive 0 points for the corresponding question!
