PhD positions (70 % - 100%)

The research of the chair focuses on empirical research with an emphasis on disclosure decisions of companies and on corporate governance structures. Applicants should have a strong interest in these topics and ideally possess a background in these fields (accounting, corporate finance, economics).

Successful candidates will become part of the Swiss Doctoral Program Network in Accounting Research (DAR-CH), jointly organized by the Universities of Basel, Bern, Neuchâtel and Zurich. DAR-CH offers a highly competitive doctoral study program that provides its participants with the relevant knowledge and skills to conduct scholarly accounting research and prepares them for a successful academic career in the field of accounting. Courses are held by faculty members from the participating institutions as well as renowned professors from leading universities in the U.S. and Europe. The program offers excellent opportunities for international network building within the international academic accounting community. Applicants should hold an excellent master's degree specializing in accounting, economics or finance. In addition, the positions require advanced writing and communication skills in English. The positions also involve limited teaching and research assistance. To this end, a fluent command of the German language is an advantage but not necessary.
