Workshop overview

The workshop aims at intensively discussing research papers of the course participants with and by Prof. Edward Paul Lazear, Prof. Dr. Uschi Backes-Gellner, and all other participants. Papers discussed should be either in the field of personnel economics or economics of education.

Credit Requirements and Grading

- 1. Presentation of your own research project during the workshop (30 min).
- 2. Full workshop attendance and reading of all participants' papers. Students are expected to come prepared to the workshop. It will facilitate discussions and improve overall learning.
- 3. Writing a referee report on a colleague's paper that is discussed during the workshop. The referee report (approx. two pages) should be written with respect to style, clarity of argument, etc. The report has to be sent to the presenter and to patrick.lehnert@business.uzh.ch within two weeks after the seminar
- 4. Grading is on a pass/fail basis.

Target audience

The workshop is designed for doctoral students in business and economics, particularly but not solely from personnel economics or economics of education.
