### Workshop overview

The workshop aims at intensively discussing research papers of the course participants with and by Prof. Dr. Eric Bettinger and Prof. Dr. Dr. h.c. Uschi Backes-Gellner, and all other participants. Papers discussed should be either in the field of economics of education or personnel economics.

## **Credit Requirements and Grading**

- 1. Presentation of your own research project during the workshop (30 min).
- 2. Full workshop attendance and reading of all participants' papers. Students are expected to come prepared to the workshop. It will facilitate discussions and improve overall learning.
- 3. Writing a referee report on a colleague's paper that is discussed during the workshop. The referee report (approx. two pages) should be written with respect to style, clarity of argument, etc. The report has to be sent to the presenter and to <u>damiano.pregaldini@business.uzh.ch</u> within two weeks after the seminar.
- 4. Grading is on a pass/fail basis.

#### **Target audience**

The workshop is designed for doctoral students in business and economics, particularly but not solely from economics of education and personnel economics.

# **Preliminary Schedule**

The workshop takes place in the form of an intensive 3-day workshop outside the University, in Laax, GR, Switzerland (Hotel Signina: https://www.signinahotel.com/en/) Sunday, January 23, 2022 (starting approx. 2 pm) Monday, January 24 (all day – including a break for joint outdoor activities) Tuesday, January 25 (all day – including a break for joint outdoor activities) Wednesday, January 26 (ending approx. 1 pm).

## **Expected costs**

Hotel rates per person per night (double rooms), including breakfast and dinner, are CHF 175 pp. Admitted students are requested to book their accommodation individually at the hotel Signina by October 29<sup>th</sup>, 2021. Further details will be provided after admission to the workshop.

The number of participants is limited. Workshop application at the chair is mandatory **until October**  $3^{rd}$ , **2021**. UZH students who need to know whether they are accepted for the course before the end of the official booking deadline have to apply until September 26<sup>th</sup> and will be notified before October 8<sup>th</sup>, 2021.
