




Entwicklung der Konzeptionen von Weltsystemen/Weltgesellschaft









State Fragility Index 2010




Figure 1. State Fragility in the Global System




Global network of car industry



Nutella Global Value Chain




Complexity: Network of twitter-conversations (1 hour)



Network of global players


- **43.000 global players**






Figure 7: Testing Economic and Environmental Resilience Constellation
